

IQAC REPORT 2015-16

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been established in the college on 28/02/2013 by the hands of Dr. Sudhir Patil, Ex-Vice-Chancellor Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Dr. S. E. Pawar, Scientist BARC, Mumbai and every activity is monitored through it. Accordingly every activity is performed through action plan prepared by IQAC at the beginning of every session and action taken report is prepared. NAAC has been a guiding force for the present and future programmes, functions and activities. As per the suggestions of the Peer Team, the college has taken many measures to enhance the quality of higher education.

Significant Activities and Contributions made by IQAC during the last session can be enumerated as follows:

1. IQAC has distributed Seven Criteria of NAAC by constituting different Committees.
2. Regular Meetings and Monitoring of the Quality Work in the institution is done through IQAC.
3. Academic Planning and Review is done by IQAC.
4. Academic Audit of Faculty. (Feedback, Daily Notes & Diary, Meetings)
5. Orientation Program for First Year / Semester I Students.
6. Exit Meeting for Last Year students.
7. Competitive Exam classes conducted.
8. Spoken English Classes conducted throughout the year in collaboration with Job Masters.in.
9. Two Short term courses initiated (Spoken English and Comp. Exam.)
10. IQAC has motivated faculties to generate Revenue and accordingly revenue of Rs. 10520/- generated by various Departments through consultancy and counselling.
11. It is the result of IQAC motivation that number of Students achieved Medals, Ranks, Prizes at International/National /State and Regional Level activities as follows :
 - i) Participation of 02 students in the Essay Competition on Gandhiji: A Multidimensional Great Man organized by Gandhi Smarak Nidhi, Mumbai, one student achieved **First Prize in Hindi and other won the Consolation Prize and Certificate**.
 - ii) Participation of 06 students in All India Essay writing competition organized by Shri Ramchandra Mission and United Nations Information Center for India and Bhutan (UNIC) at *Regional level* one student achieved **Gold Medal and 03 students best essayist certificate** for the consecutive Second Year.
 - iii) One student was selected and completed the *Natak va Loksangit Abhinav Prashikshan Course* organised by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Research & Training Institution, Pune. (BARTI).
 - iv) 03 Students participated in an Elocution Competition *Swachata Mitra Vakrutva Karandak Spardha* 2015 at Tahsil Level, out of 02 students secured First and Second Rank respectively. At District Level 1 student participated and secured Second Rank. This event was organized by Water Supply and Health Dept. Government of Maharashtra and Zilla Parishad, Wardha.
 - v) Eklavya General Knowledge Examination, Nagpur First Prize with Shield.

- vi) 15 Students of institution participated & 1 secured Second Rank in Poster Competition in 7th National Level Technical Event Blitz Krieg 2016 organized by Dept of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering of Datta Meghe Institute of Engineering Technology and Research, Wardha.
- vii) On the occasion of 125th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, various colleges organised number of competitions, 1 Student participated and secured First Rank in Inter Collegiate Bheem Geet Gayan Competition. 1 Student secured Consolation Prize in Inter Collegiate Essay Competition.
- viii) The Institution itself organised Inter Collegiate Debate Competition on the occasion of Swami Vivekanand Birth Anniversary in which number of college students participated.
- ix) Recognizing the importance of Disaster Management the Institution sent its 02 student and 01 faculty to attend 10 days Disaster Management Training Camp "Avhan" at Mumbai.

12. Owing liability to Society, the IQAC, this year highlighted Social Work and Activities and motivated various departments to work accordingly. As a result, various departments in collaboration performed activities related to social work such as Medicine, Clothes and blanket distribution to Old Age Home, School Uniform to Anganwadi Students, cloth distribution to New Born Baby at Rural Hospital, Pulgaon, Fruits, cloth distribution and cleanliness at Special Ability School, Awareness rallies, Surveys etc.

Major Activities during the year in the sphere of extension activities and Institutional Social Responsibility:

❖ Long Term Projects/Plans :

- *Orange Plants Distribution :*

Vidarbha Region especially Nagpur is known as Orange City, to nurture and foster this Cult College has distributed free Orange Plants to 100 Students with dual purpose of highlighting the popularity and creating Social and Environmental Awareness. The Institution with long term 05 years plan initiated a purpose of tracing and tracking of growth of orange plant distributed to first year students, which will also be tracked in the second and final year in order to make proper record.

- *Wastage Collection & Wormi Composed :*

As per the last year future plan, the Institution continuously pursuing Wastage Collection Campaign (*Nirmalya Sankalan*) to the response of people around the village and to carry Wormy Composed Project in the Institution. This project has been successfully carried out this year; it has been helpful to the Botanical Garden of the Institution itself, provided to local farmers and started to generate revenue.

- Curry leaves (*Mitha Neem*) project is successfully carried out by plantation of Curry trees (*Murriya koenigii*) in the garden of Institution. Similarly Department of Botany has also initiated a project of extracting and selling Juice of Long Melon/ Bottle Gourd from Botanical Garden.

- Accordingly revenue of Rs. 10520/- generated this year from these projects.

❖ **Short Term Projects/Plans :**

• ***Ek Mutthi Anaj :***

As per the last year future plan, the Institution initiated this project by way of collecting grain from students and staff and donated to Late Shahabanubai Hirani old age home for Women, at the same time Fruits, Medicine ,Shawls, clothes and Quilts are also donated. Students and staff members enthusiastically participated in this activity.

- Some departments of the Institution distributed Cloths, fruits and sweets to Deaf and Dumb School and distribution of School Uniform to Anganwadi Students of Malakapur and Kurzadi fort. Similarly clothes distributed to New Born Baby at Rural Hospital, Pulgaon.
- The Institution is fully aware about Health & Hygiene and accordingly carried Programmes and Camps in collaboration with Gram Panchayat, Aпти - Free Blood Group Detection camp and Hemoglobin Estimation Camps organized at Aпти. Similarly Dental Checkup Camp also organized in collaboration with Rural Hospital, Pulgaon for the students of the college.
- The Institution initiated Water Testing Center in the college to the benefit of Students, Staff and the People of the nearby villages.
- The Institution organized Workshops on Quilt making in order to donate to old age home and new born babies (Rural Hospital, Pulgaon). Similarly workshop on Brown Paper Bags making organized in order to create awareness to avoid the use of plastic bags. Workshop on Embroidery organized to develop skill in students.
- The Institution conducted Survey on out school students, made its proper documentation and submitted to the University.

Thus, IQAC continuously Contribute, Monitor and Evaluate the Teaching & Learning processes in the institution by way of implementing -Three Digital classrooms as per Digital Class Room Time Table and departmental ICT teaching, Surprise visit of IQAC Coordinator /Principal to class room, Academic Audit of Teachers, Feedback on Teaching from students, Continuous evaluation through Unit Tests/Terminal Exams/Assignments/Group Discussion & Quiz, The IQAC through its regular meetings guides and monitors the quality works in the institution, IQAC evolves new strategies & suggest means for assessing students' progress.
